He was also a philosopher and principal founder of Reformational philosophy [1] with Dirk Vollenhoven , [2] a significant development within the Neocalvinist (or Kuyperian) school of thought.

Dooyeweerd stands firmly in the Dutch Reformed tradition and a very important figure in this was Abraham Kuyper (1837-1920). He was primarily a politician—being Holland's Prime Minister from 1901 to 1905—but he strongly believed that Christian principles should affect every area of

Sphere Sovereignty was first formulated at the turn of the 20th century by the Neo-Calvinist theologian and Dutch prime minister Abraham Kuyper and further developed by philosopher Herman Dooyeweerd. Kuyper based the idea of sphere sovereignty partially on the Christian view of existence coram Deo , every part of human life exists equally and directly “before the face of God.”

Dooyeweerd was an intellectual heir of Kuyper who grew up and lived his life within the Gereformeerde Kerken in Nederland (Reformed Churches in the Netherlands) and the network of institutions established by the members of that church body, including the Anti-Revolutionary Party, which participated in coalition governments in the Netherlands until just over four decades ago when it merged with two other Christian parties to form the Christian Democratic Appeal.
