MD-110 Chapter 9. Sections 1614.401(a)-(e) of 29 C.F.R. identify those entitled to file appeals to the Commission. 29 C.F.R. § 1614.402(a) provides that appeals to the Commission must be filed by complainant within thirty (30) days [1] of receipt of an agency's final action - that is, a dismissal, final agency decision (FAD), final order, or final determination.

EEOC can order compliance with both settlement agreements and final decisions, and, in the case of a settlement breach, order that the complaint be reinstated from the point processing ceased.

A: Under the new regulations and the new MD-110, both the complainant and the agency may appeal a decision by an administrative judge on an individual complaint. The time for a complainant to appeal is still 30 days from receipt of the agency's final action or dismissal.
